

Fr. Meredith reported plans for 40 hours of Eucharistic Adoration on January 6, 7 & 8. There will be a prayer service on Friday evening, January 6; Mass on Saturday evening and a prayer service Sunday evening. Guest preachers will be invited.

Fr. Meredith reported that St. Pius X has set their date for Koinonia and he will follow up with them to set a date for a Koinonia here. Fr. reiterated that the biggest challenge will be finding a time when the parish hall can be reserved for the three days needed.

Libby updated the council re: the Olan Mills brochure. 500 copies will be supplied free of charge. The brochure will be trifold which will recognize parish and school activities.

The Hospitality Chair role was discussed. Instead of naming one chair, it was suggested that small groups be formed for specific functions or needs. An individual name would be taken from a list of parishioners' who would head up the activities as they are needed. There would be a list of parishioner names that would be used to choose from to head a particular activity or function.

The Maintenance Committee Chair position was discussed. The question of whether the position should be put in the bulletin was not agreed upon. It was decided that if the position is placed in the bulletin, then it will need to be qualified so that appropriate candidates would apply. It was suggested that instead of posting a need for a chair, a posting would be put in the bulletin asking for people to join the committee. It is hoped that a chair could be identified from members who may join the committee. Libby will talk to Steve Kinnard about identifying the needs for a maintenance committee.

Fr. Meredith reported that he has a meeting with Suzanne Cotthoff on Nov. 28th to discuss reactivating the stain glass project. He will find out what the plans are and what the cost is going to be.

The Constitution changes will be reviewed by Rocky and Dawn before the January PPC meeting. Suggested changes and copies of the Constitution will be emailed prior to the January meeting for all members to review.

Domonique reported on the Soccer Field project. She stated that Phillip Garnett will donate dozer work. It is unsure how much rock will be encountered. Bart questioned safety issues, school liability, and planning commission codes. Fr. Meredith said that he would like to see crossing guards with signs to assist with child safety. Mayor Kemp is willing to maintain the crossing area. The PTO will donate \$ 1500.00 for grass seed and an individual has donated \$ 250.00. The cost of a fence was discussed and it was suggested by Carl that a cyclone chain link net be considered. Dawn suggested fund raising to cover the net cost. Fr. Meredith advised that a probe for ledge be done first. It was discussed that the construction of the soccer field would improve the value of the land and also would contribute to increased school spirit by keeping a sport on campus. Domonique to report further updates at the next PPC meeting.

Domonique reported that the BLT met Nov 17th and the teams have met with parents and staff for their input. Families want K thru 12 but the urgent need is 5 thru 8. The focus will be on the 5th thru 8th grade facility. The teachers had simple requests, more storage and outlets. Branscum gave a presentation to

the BLT with ideas on how to keep the project open for growth. Rocky commented that the parish has to be behind the project but that there has to be trust first. Fr. Meredith reported that an operational prospectus using the diocesan process will be utilized. Fr. Meredith stated that classes will be held where ever they can be accommodated, if the present school facilities become inhabitable, until construction is completed. Domonique will report back at the next PPC meeting.
